The HHW facility is closed the weekend of Thanksgiving and the last two weeks in December.

California Department of Transportation limits the transport of hazardous materials to 15 gallons or 125 pounds of waste.

* Sharps/needles must be in puncture-proof container. Loose needles will not be accepted.

Bulky Items

Chula Vista residents with curbside service can have up to ten (10) bulky items (appliances, mattresses, furniture, etc.) removed per week free of charge. *Call Republic Services at (619) 421-9400 to schedule your pick-up at least 24 hours before your service day.*

Landfill & Yard Waste Passes

Residents with a current account receive two (2) landfill and yard waste passes per year, and each pass is valid for 60 days. *Call Republic Services at (619) 482-4024 for additional information on the passes.*

RECYCLING



Dry food boxes, packaging, paper bags, cardboard, white paper, colored paper, letters and junk mail



Milk cartons and juice boxes



Magazines, newspapers, catalogs, phone books



Empty metal paint or aerosol cans



Often in electronic or appliance packaging (NO Peanut or packing Styrofoam)



Glass or plastic bottles and jars, plus all CRV containers



Shredded paper in a clear see through bag



Steel, tin, pie tins, wire hangers, aluminum cans, foil, plus all CRV containers

Don't trash a good thing. **Recycle it!**

Recyclables that are contaminated with trash or are put in plastic bags must be disposed of as trash — defeating the whole purpose of recycling!

Did You Know?
Every ton of recycled paper saves 380 gallons of oil and 7,000 gallons of water.

By recycling one aluminum can, enough energy is saved to run a TV or computer for three hours.

Americans throw away more than 2.5 million plastic bottles every hour.

YARD WASTE



Leaves, lawn clippings, wood chips, weeds, dried vegetation, fruits and vegetables, branches/twigs, and unpainted/untreated wood



Only Clean, Green Material Accepted



Chula Vista's Yard Waste is composted.



Help us avoid contamination of the compost by keeping all plastics, Styrofoam, cigarette butts and other trash out of the yard waste bin.

TRASH



Diapers, styrofoam, plastic bags of all types, soiled food packaging, wrappers, plastic cutlery, and all heavily-used items that cannot be donated.



Do NOT put these in the trash:

- Hot ashes
- Debris from construction, remodeling or demolition
- Household Hazardous Waste
- Dirt, rocks and concrete



Keep a lid on it!

Keeping the lid closed on your trash receptacle will help keep your complex beautiful by:

- Reducing the number of insects, rats and other pests.
- Minimizing odors
- Discouraging illegal dumping
- Protecting our local watershed by keeping debris out of the storm drain.
