After I gave him the information that I had, the private investigator, Oscar Garcia (***-****), told me that he could not find any information here in San Diego because he believed that my veteran had died in Los Angeles and believed that his mother may still be alive in Los Angeles, but his fee would be much higher to continue the search because he would have to be contacting investigators from L.A. Due to the fact that I am only a student and that the money was coming out of my pocket, I had to refuse the offer of continuing the search for more money. This gave me sufficient information to know that I was not going to be able to find any information on Arthur Givens here in San Diego and that if I wanted to continue my search I would have to do so in L.A.
