

Joseph Francis Gould (1924 – 1944)

Joseph Gould and his mother, Mrs. Genevieve Reinback lived in Chula Vista, CA. The 1930 Census shows the only Joseph F. Gould born in Jefferson County, Georiga and five years old.

He was a Seaman Second Class (E2) in the United States Navy Reserve.

He died on November 18, 1944 and is buried in the National Cemetery in the Philippines. There is a street in the Sunbow community of Chula Vista named in his honor. During this time, there were several battles in the Leyte Gulf and Surigao Strait region in the Philippine Islands.

He was awarded the Purple Heart.
