

William E. Irwin (19.. – 194.)

At this time, the only thing known about William E. Irwin was that he had enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps and that he was a Private First Class (E2).

He died during WWII and his wife, Mrs. William E. Irwin lived at 561-A Shasta Drive, Vista Square, Chula Vista, CA.

There was only one William E. Irwin found buried in a National Military Cemetery, and that is in Baltimore. However, he was listed as a Marine Corporal and he died in November 1941. There were no "William Irwin's" found buried in an overseas military cemetery.

A street in the Montecito Ridge subdivision of Otay Ranch honors his name.
