

Robert K. Johnson (1916 – 1945)

PFC Robert K. Johnson, United States Army, of San Diego died on April 10, 1945 as a result of enemy actions in the Republic of the Philippines. His body was repatriated to the United States. He was born in Montana in April, 1916, and was living in Portland Oregon in 1920. By 1930, he is living with his mother in Los Angeles.

He is survived by his mother, Mrs. (Florence) Edith Murray of Los Angeles and his father, Mr. Ingman J. Johnson. In addition, he had two sisters (Mrs. Claudia Myers, and Mrs. Mildred Weir), a daughter Sylvia Beth Johnson and two sons, Clifford and Robert Keith Johnson Jr.

His obituary appeared in the *San Diego Union* newspaper on Page 13 of the February 9, 1949 issue. Services were held for him in the Church of the Reclusion at the Forrest Lawn Cemetery in Glendale California, where he is buried.

He moved to the San Diego area in 1935, and was a member of the Central Christian Church.
